"Is there life on Mars? Is there life in Peckham?" So sung Alexei Sayle in his 1982 number 1 single, 'Ullo John, got a new motor?'. We present the definitive answer to this cruel slur.

Life in Peckham is an exhibition of art based on four periods of Peckham's history; 18th Century Peckham, 19th Century Peckham, Peckham in the first half of the 20th Century and Peckham since 1945.

Four artists, Ted Litchfield, Heather Martin, Vik and Amanda Egbe have been working in the Academy at Peckham and St Thomas the Apostle schools to create art work based on these periods in collaboration with **Peckham Society** and the local history library in Borough.

The exhibition will also reveal a statement given exclusively by Alexei Sayle to clear up the question he left hanging for 26 years.

The project is an Arts Express production funded by the Heritage Lottery and Southwark Council.

Also launched at this event local historian, Stephen Bourne, will launch his new publication on the life of Dr Harold Moody, a key black historical figure who lived and worked in Peckham.
